Adrian Wong was born and raised in Chicago, Illinois in 1980. Originally trained in research psychology (receiving a Master's degree from Stanford University in 2003), he began making and exhibiting work in San Francisco while concurrently conducting experiments on young children. He continued his post-graduate studies at Yale University, where he received an MFA in 2005. He has been based in Hong Kong since 2005. His recent exhibitions include the traveling exhibition "Troglodyte See the Light," "A Passion for Creation" for the Louis Vuitton Fondation pour la Création, and "Hong Kong Eye" at the Saatchi Gallery. His videos have been screened internationally at the Internationale Kurzfilmtage Oberhausen, Bangkok Experimental Film Festival, and Kunsthalle Wien. His works are collected by numerous public and private collections including the Kadist Foundation (San Francisco), the Uli Sigg Collection (Lucerne), the DSL Foundation Collection (Paris), and the William Lim Collection (Hong Kong).
